

Dear Parents,

St. Vincent de Paul School will be continuing with the Granite School District Lunch Program this year. Sheldon Moore, the director of the program, is excited to continue serving nutritious and affordable meals (\$1.50 per meal for grades Pre-K through 6; \$1.65 for grades 7 and 8). If you are new to the Granite Lunch Program, you may register at PayPams.com. Mr. Moore recommends using the option on PayPams which automatically takes the funds from your bank account when the balance is low, but that is not required.

According to St. Vincent School's new contract with Granite School District, our students will not receive lunch if their account balance is \$5 in the negative or lower. You will receive repeated notices from PayPams when your balance is low. If your child does not receive a lunch from the Granite Lunch program, one of the secretaries will call you to bring a lunch for your child.
